WHERE TO START



- Divide into teams of 7.
- Have each team take a seat at their table, so that everyone can see the screen (or the sheets of paper with a printout of the patterns being put together).
- Check that each group has a set of 7 puzzle pieces.



TANGRAM PRINCIPLE



THERE ARE 7 PIECES TO THE PUZZLE

- We use all of them in each shape we are putting together.
- They meet with their edges, never overlap.
- They can be rotated freely they do not have a 'front' and 'back'.








TANGRAM PRINCIPLE:
